Report on present issues

Opening: David Howman, WADA Director General

- More expensive sample collections needed in the future (EPO etc.)
- 25 % of prohibited substances from black market
- Athlete Biological Passport (blood collection) – legal sustainability
- ADAMS, 115 ADOs & 30 000 athletes – ongoing enhancements
- Compliance report, June - Nov. 2011
- Code review in 2012, 4th World Conference in November 2013, revised Code coming into force in 2015.

Report on present issues (cont.)

Summary of the most interesting topics during the Symposium:

- Blood Testing imperatives (Stuart Kemp) + Biological Passport & Practical implementation of Blood Testing Programs (Olivier Banuls, UCI)
 - 36h max between blood sample collection and analysis (budget: 4.3M CHF/3.5M CHF)
 - Encourage blood testing
- Code Compliance (Rune Andersen)
 - 2011 Code Compliance year
 - Interim Code Compliance reports in May and September 2011
 - Official Code Compliance report in November 2011
 - Requirements:
 - Acceptance of the code, incorporating rules in line with the Code
 - The following must also be on the programs: Education, TUE system, Results management system, in- and out of competition testing programs.
- Code Revision Plan
 - 1st consultation phase (1 Dec. 2011 – 15 Mar. 2012) draft at Exco May 2012
 - 2nd consultation phase draft at Exco Nov 2012
 - 3rd consultation phase draft at Exco May 2013
 - Final draft at Exco September 2013
 - World Conference Nov. 2013
- ADAMS: Recent Developments (Stuart Kemp)
 - Athlete feedback/ why we ask for information
 - Minimize training requirements?
- Anti-doping education (Rob Koehler) Information & Education
 - Outreach programs
 - Say NO! to Doping
 - At a Glance program/Dangers of Doping leaflet
 - Play True Challenge game/Coach True program (on-line learning program), Doping control videos (Say NO! to Doping logos, mixed zone, videos)
